

New Delta MP snags parliamentary appointment

Delta-Richmond East Conservative MP Kerry-Lynne Findlay has been appointed as the parliamentary secretary to Justice Minister Rob Nicholson.

Prime Minister Stephen Harper announced last Wednesday the rookie MP and two other B.C. MPs - Randy Kamp (Pitt Meadows-Maple Ridge-Mission) and Andrew Saxton (North Vancouver) - were among 28 appointed as parliamentary secretaries.

Findlay is a Vancouver lawyer who has been active in the Canadian Bar Association, including being the founding chair of the B.C. Women Lawyers Forum and National Women Lawyers Forum, chair of the Constitutional Law Section and a former president for the B.C. branch of the bar association.

As part of their responsibilities, parliamentary secretaries frequently represent their minister in parliamentary committees and work closely with members of Parliament in the House of Commons.
